You will need to provide photo ID and a business card or utility bill with business/tenant name and address, or City of Toronto property tax bill).

Per *The City of Toronto Municipal Code, Chapter 19, Business Improvement Area*, only members of the BIA and their legal representatives (proof required) are eligible to vote at the AGM. A "person" is defined by Chapter 19 to include "a corporation and the heirs, executors, administrators or other legal representatives of a person to whom the context can apply according to the law." **No person in attendance shall have more than one vote.**

The meeting will also be live-streamed for **viewing purposes only** and a link will be sent to you once you register. As a registered Little Italy BIA member, you will also have access to the 2021 AGM Minutes, 2021 Report of Audited Financial Statements, and the 2023 Proposed Program and Budget at https://tolittleitaly.com/bia-meetings/.
